2026 SEASON REGISTRATIONS

Bayside United FC is thrilled to announce the 2026 Winter Season Registrations are now open!

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

Registration is a two step process for some age groups - see below for a walkthrough. The process is the same whether you are registering for a high performance squad or a community team.

STEP 1: REGISTER IN BAYSIDE UNITED FC KICK HUB (ALL PLAYERS)

Register with Bayside United FC using the **REGISTER NOW** button on the club website [BAYSIDE UNITED FC CLUB](#) (Kick Hub), providing all requested information.

Registrations can be processed for one or more family members in the one transaction. Once all family members registrations are complete, the amount due can be paid:

- In full (at the time of registration)
- With a deposit and balance in instalments by applying for a payment plan (at the time of registration) **All fees must be settled by no later than 4 weeks prior to your season start date or 21 February 2026 (whichever is earlier).**

TO ENSURE ALL PLAYERS ARE APPROPRIATELY INSURED, BAYSIDE UNITED FC MUST MANDATE A NO PAY, NO PLAY POLICY.

STEP 2: REGISTER WITH FOOTBALL QUEENSLAND & FOOTBALL AUSTRALIA

Players in inter-club competitions only (MiniRoos (U9-U12), Juniors (U13-U18), Metro & Seniors/U23 only) are required to register with Football Queensland (FQ) & Football Australia (FA). Masters register with QMF via FQ.

When completing the registration in the Squadi app for FQ and PlayFootball website for FA you will be required to pay the respective affiliation fees. These affiliation fees are a mandatory requirement by the governing bodies which also include player insurance for the season for players in an approved FQ competition.

We will provide the registration link and user guide to players once FQ & FA open their systems for 2026 registrations.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - FEES

To assist making the registration process as accessible as possible we have collated a few frequently asked questions. If you question is not on this list, please email our very helpful Registrar, Deanna Brown, for assistance (registrar@baysideunited.com.au)

What will 2026 fees be?

We are happy to confirm fees will remain inline with 2025. Fees including Football Queensland & Football Australia Affiliation Fees are set out in the table above. An early bird discount has been offered for most groups, please see table above.

When are fees due to be paid?

To ensure all players are appropriately insured, Bayside United FC is required to mandate a strict 'no pay, no play' policy. Player fees must be paid in full 4 weeks prior to season start or 21 February 2026 (whichever is earlier) to commence playing at the start of season.

Is payment required at registration?

A deposit per player is required at registration with the balance to be paid in full or in instalments by applying for a payment plan (at the time of registration) by 21 February 2026. All fees must be settled by no later than 4 weeks prior to your season start date or 21 February 2026 (whichever is earlier). If you do not receive an email you have not completed the registration.

Do you accept government Play On vouchers?

Yes, please supply voucher details during registration. Vouchers will not be accepted after registration.

Can I start a payment plan when regos open?

Yes! This is the best time so you can spread payment of your fees over the coming months until the due date of 21/2/26. For Junior, Metro and Senior teams payment plans are to be completed before start of season.



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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – REGISTERING A PLAYER

Why will team & player numbers be capped?

As much as we'd love to register unlimited teams we are restricted to the amount of teams we can fit on our fields to train and play. We recommend registering as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

What age group do I register for/can my child play in a different age group?

You register in the age group equivalent to the age you will turn in that year. E.g. if your child is turning 9 in 2026, you will be playing in the U9 competition. Our system includes reference to birth year in the Playing Group menu options.

Players who register outside of their playing group may require Bayside United FC to obtain dispensation from Football Queensland. If registering outside your normal age group, please email registrar@baysideunited.com.au and provide further information on your child's registration and our Registrar will discuss eligibility for dispensation if required.

Who has to register?

You have to be 18 years old to complete a registration. If a player is not yet 18 years old, their parent or guardian will need to register them.

Where do I register first? Bayside United FC or Squadi?

Register via the [REGISTER NOW](#) button on our webpage. This registration will take you straight to our Bayside United FC registration system. Players registering in the MiniRoos U9-U12, Juniors & Seniors competitions will be required to complete a further registration with Football Queensland and Football Australia. We will let you know when their systems (Squadi/PlayFootball) are open for 2026 registrations.

What if I don't know my team for next year?

This is completely fine! Please register and Choose Place me in a team and we will place you in a team.

How do I play with my friends?

We love friends playing together and do our best to make it happen. Include your friends full names in the medical notes section during registration. All friends should do the same to allow the Club to match up friends. We try our absolute best but cannot guarantee friends playing together.

How do I know if my registration was successful?

You will receive a confirmation email/invoice if your registration is successful. Please check your spam/junk folder if you did not receive an email. If you do not believe you have received an email,



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please email registrar@baysideunited.com.au and we will follow up for you.

I have registered, what happens next?

Our club administrators will allocate you / your child to a team. Once teams are allocated, we will be in touch and discuss the next steps. For players U6-U12, you will be invited to Meet your Team Day which is proposed for 14 March 2026 but will be confirmed with you directly.



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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – COACHING, TEAM MANAGEMENT, VOLUNTEERING AND TRAINING

When does the season start?

What day is training?

Training days are organised through your coach and managers. Days and times should be discussed as a group to best accommodate all players. Training will be held once weekly, however for teams aged U13 and above this is at the discretion of the coach and availability of training fields.

BUDS teams training days are set by Bayside United FC Coaching Director, and normally held on Tuesday and Thursday.

Can I Coach or Manager my child's team?

We are a community club, which is reflected in our fees. To keep our fees as low as possible, we rely on parents to step forward to be the Coach or Manager of our teams. We do not provide Coaches and Managers for our teams.

As a token of thanks, we are pleased to offer our coaches and managers a club discount which will be credited at the start of term 3 and can be applied to future player registration fees or merchandise.

Can I nominate to volunteer next season?

Yes! Our club is run 100% by volunteers, including a volunteer committee. At the time of registration we encourage you to express interest in volunteering. If you have a preference in how you would like to help our club, you can let us know at the time of registering.

When can jerseys and training kits be collected?

Your Team Manager or Coach will be informed when jerseys are ready for collection. Generally collection is one week prior to season start for your respective age group.
